The Program: "Introduction to Lyric Power"

PROGRAM GOALS:

To promote breakthroughs in behavioral transformation for students while utilizing a nationally multi-award-winning audio music CD. The program promotes respect, unity, self-confidence and media awareness.

The accompanying video DVD integrates positive aspects of pop culture while promoting literacy, academic achievement, appropriate behavior and resources for youth in need of support.

FEATURES:

- Designed for Upper Elementary and Middle-School populations (Grades 4-9)
- Compliant with Schoolwide "Positive Behavior Support," (PBS) a federal initiative introduced in 2001.
- May be used within any schools' PBS plan- as an introduction to PBS or reinforcement.

PROGRAM PROCESS:

- 1) Teacher reviews package, writes notes relating to curriculum, schedules classroom date, arranges to have TV with DVD player in place
- 2) In classroom, teacher begins by playing the DVD (under 10 min.)
- 3) When finished, teacher refers to the curriculum to open dialog with students about what they watched.
- 4) Students are requested to write a one page essay about what they learned from the video and the session within 3 school days. Guide sheets are provided with helpful tips from the book: Blueprint for Exceptional Writing (J. Fonenot, Pearson Publishing).
- 5) 3 school days Later: Students turn in essays.
- 6) Teacher reviews essays and selects 5 that reflect a true understanding of the curriculum as related to Schoolwide PBS, to be read by the students in front of the class.
- 7) The 5 students receive the "You Stand Out!" certificate and all students receive a copy of the "Youth Under Construction" CD.
